





Birth control methods 4 birth control reminders












Text Messages and Pulse Control













Outcomes

Primary behavioral outcomes

- Increase contraceptive use during sexual intercourse
- Increase hormonal (birth control pills, the shot, the patch, and the ring) or longacting reversible contraceptive (LARC) method (IUDs and implants) use during sexual intercourse


Secondary outcome measures

- Increase contraceptive knowledge
- More favorable attitudes toward birth control and accessing sexual and reproductive health services
- Improve birth control and sexual and reproductive health self-efficacy
- Increase intentions to use birth control during future intercourse
- Increase intentions to visit a health care provider for sexual or reproductive health services






Survey Completion Rates

average number of minutes spent on the app by intervention participants



Text Message Efficacy

75%

of intervention participants received all text messages

20%

experienced a message that bounced back (was not successfully delivered)

14%

of intervention participants opted out of receiving text messages
